Roadmap to easing Queensland's restrictions

The Wolston Park GC COVID-19 Operations Sub-committee have met to discuss the new easing of restrictions by the Queensland Government and the impact this will have on our golf club. Stage 1 of the Government's easing of restriction's comes into effect on Friday 15 May 2020 (for at least 4 weeks).

Outdoor non-contact activities (this includes golf) are now allowed a gathering of up to 10 people. This now allows us to increase the playing group from 2 players to 4 players and will take effect from Saturday 16 May 2020. The timesheet for this Saturday will be released Thursday at 4.00pm. Tee-times will be available from both the 1st and 10th tees for the morning field, as we have in the past.

Social Distancing and good hygiene guidelines and restrictions are still in place. It is imperative that all golfers adhere to the following precautions and procedures.

- Respect the social distancing rules in and around the pro shop and on course
- **No alcohol** is allowed on course
- Pro Shop - **Only 1 customer** is permitted inside the Pro Shop.
- Golf Carts – **1 player per cart***Single Use Only
- Flagsticks are in place but please DO NOT touch them
- Bunker rakes have been removed (please see local rule)
- Water Fountains and Ball Washers are not operational
- **No Cash** - We ask that our customers use EFTPOS
